

wise Bible teacher once told me that a perfect sermon for the Jewish rabbis had three points and should take one point from the Torah, one from the Psalms, and one from the prophets.

In the story of Jesus' transfiguration on top of a mountain, God's presence, in the form of a cloud, descends on the three disciples Jesus had brought with him as he converses with Moses and Elijah. As they tremble in fear at all they were seeing, a voice says these three things – 'this is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him'.

In Psalm 2 (one of the great messianic psalms oft quoted by the New Testament writers), verse 7 says, 'I will proclaim the Lord's decree: He said to me, 'You are my son; today I have become your father.' The whole psalm speaks of God installing his perfect king who will subdue the nations under God's final rule.

Isaiah 42:1, at the start of the first of Isaiah's great servant songs, God says to the prophet, 'Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will bring justice to the nations.' God's servant will enjoy his favour and will bring the nations justice.

Lastly, in Deuteronomy 18:15, Moses prophecies, 'The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your fellow Israelites. You must listen to him.'

God told a fearful Peter, John, and James exactly what they needed to know: who Jesus was and what they were to do – listen to what he had to say.

As we tremble before all that is happening in our world today, let's remember that Jesus is the Son and Chosen One of God, before whom the nations will kneel and to whom he will bring his perfect justice.

We are to listen to all he has taught us and follow him.

As you join us in prayer, I pray you will hold the truth of who Jesus is in your heart and grow in hope and faith as you follow him.

Pray for the Commission on Palliative and End of Life Care to produce recommendations that will lead to great improvements in the provision of high-quality palliative care and particularly its availability to all patient groups. Pray for increased death literacy amongst our population and our churches. Pray that patients would not be fearful of palliative care or hold false beliefs about the likely experience of dying.

Praise God for the blessing of good, life-giving relationships within the CMF Nurses and Midwives' Team. Their strengths and weaknesses complement each other, reflecting the body of Christ and how its different parts function best when brought together.

MONDAY 28 APRIL

Please lift those in positions of leadership and decision-making in midwifery to the Lord. Pray that God would incline their hearts toward him, and they would be united in creating a midwifery model of care that reflects Christ's love and compassion for his people.

FRIDAY 2 MAY

Pray that nurse and midwife members working in under-resourced countries will know the joy of working in partnership with a great big God who can provide more than they we could ask or imagine.

SATURDAY 3 MAY

Monday is the International Day of the Midwife, and the theme is 'Midwives: Critical in Every Crisis'. Thank God for the work of midwives, and pray that they will be able to deliver safe and effective care throughout the world.



SUNDAY 4 MAY

HFAITH

Pray for the Abortion Law Review commissioned by the Scottish Government that is currently underway. Pray that both the lives of the mother and her unborn child will be considered by the expert group and that the recommendations being reached would serve to protect life and increase human flourishing.

MONDAY 5 MAY

Surrogate pregnancies are increasing. Pray that the wellbeing of the child will be central in discussions about amending legal frameworks. Pray that women will not be exploited but will be protected.

TUESDAY 6 MAY

Pray that following the Cass review, policy makers would commission and fund services that offer high quality evidence-based care to gender detransitioners. Pray for clinicians to move compassionately towards those who may now regret previous hormonal or surgical interventions and pray that they are offered high-quality and compassionate care for any on-going difficulties they may be facing.

REGION OF THE MONTH (MAY) South-West

WEDNESDAY 7 MAY

Pray for the establishment of the regional services to support young people who are questioning their gender. Following the Cass review, pray that these services will be commissioned and delivered to provide well-rounded care models that will compassionately address both medical and mental health needs in the young people referred to them.

THURSDAY 8 MAY

There were over 250,000 abortions in England and Wales in 2022. Pray that Christians will not become numb to this reality. Pray for the Churches and Pregnancy Crisis Round Table being held at CMF today - this time the event is focussed on helping those with abortion in their past. Pray this will be helpful for Church leaders who attend to be more equipped to minister to women and men who have abortion in their past.

FRIDAY 9 MAY

The rate of abortions in Northern Ireland increased 29 per cent in 2023-2024 -the largest percentage increase anywhere in the UK in 50 years. Pray for all who work in the health service, the devolved assembly, and the voluntary sector as they deal with the consequences.

SATURDAY 10 MAY

Pray for CMF members working in obstetrics, gynaecology, and paediatrics as they navigate the ethical issues and challenges of current reproductive and start-of-life healthcare. May they be salt and light in their workplaces, to patients and colleagues alike.



SUNDAY **11 MAY**

Pray for the CMF National Conference next weekend, as well as for the preconferences and other meetings happening during the week leading up to it. Ask the Lord to speak clearly and work powerfully through the teaching, worship, pastoral care, and fellowship at the conference.

The theme of today's **International Nurses Day** is supporting the health and wellbeing of the workforce. Pray that the importance of a nurse's spiritual wellbeing is recognised, as well as nurses' physical, mental and emotional wellbeing.
